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Dear Graduates:

As prom is approaching, we wanted to update you on a few things. The prom committee led by two grade 11 students- Sarah Mole & Erin Lee have been working to ensure your grad "Rustic Garden" is a success. The graduation is taking place on Thursday, June 28, 2017 followed by a Safe Grad event, which is led by a group of parent volunteers.

With our fundraising efforts, all Holy Heart graduates will have their cost covered for the school sponsored prom. The Safe Grad event will also be free for graduates. If you are planning on taking a guest from outside your graduating class, the cost will be \$60 for the night: \$35 meal and \$25 for safe grad.

Timeline

Meet & Greet for Parents and Graduates is at Remax Center (St. John's Curling Club from 6:00-7:00pm)

Buffet Dinner is for Graduates & Dates only in the Holy Heart Gym from 7:00-8:30pm

Entertainment/Assembly is for parents & graduates in the HHM Theatre from 8:30-10:00pm

Dance- HHM Gym 10:00-11:00pm

Safe Grad Event- Paul Reynolds Community Centre 11:30pm-5:00am

- After the dance, students should arrange to go home to change and go to the Community Centre by 12:00am.
(Students will not be admitted into safe grad after this time.)

From May 28th to June 8th from 12-1 only all graduates need to check in at the office or they will not be accounted for on Prom Day.

- **Tickets for graduates and their guest (\$60) can be purchased in the main office.**
- **Safe Grad forms need to be picked up and submitted**

Also at this time, you need to submit your table sheet and prom info sheet. Our grad info sheet allows us to track: table arrangements, "teacher buddy" info and any dietary requirements. It is important to keep within this deadline as plans need to be finalized.

As a part of our SafeProm event, we have implemented a system where all graduates speak to a teacher to be their buddy for the night. Graduates are expected to notify the teacher before the event and then the graduate will check in with their teacher buddy at the meet & greet. Teachers will have a list of their grad buddies and ensure that they have touched base with them. We want all students to be safe and have fun enjoying their night.

Parents have been hard at work getting plans underway for the safe grad. It's a great way to end the day/night with your fellow graduates before your head off to whatever lies ahead. There are lots of opportunities for parents to become involved in this event and all help and support is welcome.
